

List of topics to help study for the upcoming exams. (**Note:** Exams will be based on their textbooks both classroom and homework books. Make sure to use them to review)

Math

- Number sense (counting forwards and backwards, knowing word and numerals for numbers 1-100, finding the missing number and filling in a hundreds chart)
- Estimation
- Counting in groups
- Skip counting in 2s,5s and 10's
- Ordinal numbers (1st,2nd,3rd,4th etc...)
- Patterns
- Temperature
- Ordering events
- Shapes (2D and 3D)

English

- listen attentively to conversations, read alouds and presentations
- listen to and identify sounds in a word in sequence
- recognize and use ALL SOUNDS OF LETTERS for reading and writing
- identify, read and write high frequency words with five or six letters
- use print and pictures to convey meaning
- Recognize one's name in isolation and within text
- describe features of a familiar object with detail (HOT, COLD, SHORT, TALL...)
- state the alphabetical order correctly(a b c...)
- write simple sentences with correctly formed letters and correct ending punctuation (.?,)
- edit and proofread for conventions using tools such as word walls and personal word lists to check spelling
- write a recount in a logical sequence to present an idea with detail
- **publish** a final draft that exhibits best piece of writing and share it with a familiar audience use a capital letter for the first word of a sentence and when writing names
- use directionality left to right, top to bottom and leaves space between words when writing
- recognize and use -at, and -an (man, can, fan—cat, hat, mat...)
- use letter sound knowledge and sound blending to read texts (c a t = cat)
- form upper and lowercase letters proportionately in print (write between the lines)
- generate beginning consonant sounds in words and match sounds to a letter when reading writing (C IS FOR CAT)

- generate and expand ideas using illustration, drawings, visuals and regalia during prewriting
- contribute to discussions by sharing personal knowledge and experiences
- demonstrate comprehension of text by identifying the main idea and some details
